
My Letter Formation Book


<u>Stick Letters</u>




Long Stick starts in the sky. Tiptoe Stick pokes his head Go straight down his body and finish with a flick.

out above the grass! Don't forget to cross his arms.







Mini Stick Letters

Scoop down Jellyfish's tentacles, then add a dot on top.




Down and up Yak's horns, then scoop down under her chin.

Short Mantis always hides in the grass. Start on the grass, go straight down her body then swoop over her arm.




Down Rat's tail, then reach to his nose.



Down Newt and over the nest.




Down Meerkat and over the mangoes.

Tall Mantis Letters




Tall Mantis always has her head in the clouds. Start in the sky, go straight down her body then swoop over her arm.

Curly Caterpillar Letters




Curly Caterpillar hides in the grass. Start at his head, then curl around his body. Curly Caterpillar sometimes digs his tail into the ground. Dig down into the ground for **g** and **q**.



Curl around Crab's claw.




Around Dog, up to her ear, then down to her paw.

Around Gorilla's face, then scoop down his arm.





Around the apple and down to Ant.

Other Bug Letters






Ellie Bug starts in the middle. follow her trunk across, up and around.


Sand Snake slithers to the left, slopes down to the right and then slides back to the left.




From Elephant's mouth, go around her head to the tip of her trunk.



Slither down Snake.






Venus Fly Trap waits in the grass. Go down and up it's jaws.

X-Bugs hide in the grass. Two lines that cross is the secret agent code.




Down and up the Venus Fly Trap.

Zebra's zip goes zig, zag, zip.




Wiggly Worm wanders in the grass.


Go down and up, down and up.
