Globally, Safer Internet Day is celebrated in over a hundred countries, coordinated by the joint Insafe/INHOPE network, with the support of the European Commission, and National Safer Internet Centres across Europe.

The theme for this year's Safer Internet Day is '**Be the change: unite for a better internet**'. The day offers the opportunity to highlight positive uses of technology and to explore the role we all play in helping to create a better and safer online community. It calls upon young people, parents, carers, teachers, social workers, law enforcement, companies, policymakers, and wider, to join together in helping to create a better internet.

For Safer Internet Day at Hook Infant School the children will be focusing on "The Power of Image" and on talking to trusted adults about anything that upsets them online. Mrs Walker gave an assembly on Safer Internet Day this week to prepare the children for next weeks activities, which will revolve around the Smartie the Penguin story. We are also reviewing how the school approaches online safety and as part of this are running surveys for staff, parents and Governors on their understanding of online risks and digital technology. For parents we will shortly be updating the e-Safety page on the school's website and will use the results of the parents survey to better match your needs. If parents or carers have concerns over any online safety topic and would like to talk to someone further, you are always welcome to visit the school office and we will do our best to help where we can.
