The Year R and shortly Year 1 and Year 2, Christmas Plays have been filmed and will be uploaded to Youtube shortly. We will be sending out a Parentmail message containing a link to your child's performance. The recording of school performances has always been a fine

balance between parents who are happy to have their children filmed and those who are not. We have thought long and hard on how to accommodate all parents views where possible, but still allowing all the children to take part. We have been looking at a variety of online options to ensure your children's images are not freely available or traceable on the Internet. We have opted to use Youtube's "Unlisted" feature to ensure the videos can't be searched for, stumbled upon or included in any feeds.

The only way to access the videos is to have access to the link that we are providing to you.

We understand that some parents may wish for other family members to see their child's performance and could be tempted into sharing the link. However we strongly urge you to follow some basic e-safety rules to protect both the children and the wishes of other parents.

If you intend to share the link please ensure that ...

- you only send the link to close family members to reduce the chance of the videos ending up in the public domain;
- you only pass on the link via person to person communication, such as an email or text;
- you avoid using social networking or hosting sites to share the video or link;
- you inform anyone you send the link to about the importance of not sharing the link further.
